How It Works:

- 2. Accrue points for each participant that donates blood.
- 3. Versiti Blood Center submits all blood drive results to Indiana Sports Corp to tabulate and award points.

FAQs

What are the Divisions and Points?

Your company's Corporate Challenge team captain will know which division your company is registered in. The corresponding points are as follows:

- Division 1: (1-114 employees): 4 points per participant
- Division 2 (115-199 employees): 3 points per participant
- Division 3 and Division 4 (200 or more employees): 2 points per participant

How many blood drives can we schedule?

There is a limit of 2 blood drives that can be scheduled during the challenge.

Can employees donate twice during the challenge to collect points for the team?

Yes, employees may donate twice between May 1 and August 21 at their company's hosted drive and collect points for each donation. However, donors must wait at least 56 days between donations.

Do I need an appointment to donate?

We encourage all donors to make an appointment in advance, but it is not required. There may be a longer wait time with no advance appointment.

How do I know if I'm eligible to donate?

Eligibility information can be obtained from your company's blood drive coordinator, on versiti.org or by calling 317-916-5150.

Can anyone donate at our drives?

If the drive is open to the public and hosted by your organization, anyone can donate and your team will be credited for the donation. The determination to open participation outside of the company is up to the company scheduling the drive.

Do we get points only if someone is successful in donating blood?

Points are earned by each person who attempts to donate. The number of successful donors and the number of deferred donors comprise the number reported to ISC.

Is it safe to donate due to the outbreak of coronavirus (COVID-19)?

The donation process itself poses no risk of infecting a donor with coronavirus. If you have travelled to China, Iran, South Korea, or Italy, please self-defer from donation for 28 days from your date of return. We are monitoring and adhering to guidance from the FDA.
