



INDIANA SPORTS CORP CORPORATE CHALLENGE EVENT RULES – BOWLING

- Each company will be permitted to enter one (1) team of five (5) employees (each team must consist of at least one (1) male and one (1) female). If you have more than five (5) bowlers, you may substitute in-between games, but you may not substitute in-between frames. Teams are not allowed to switch their rotation during games or between games. Participants must wear bibs on their backs indicating their bowling order.
- This event will feature the Baker bowling system. Each team will bowl five (5) Baker games. Bowler #1 will bowl frames 1 and 6; Bowler #2 will bowl frames 2 and 7; Bowler #3 will bowl frames 3 and 8; Bowler #4 will bowl frames 4 and 9; and Bowler #5 will bowl frames 5 and 10.
- The team in each division with the highest score for all five games added together will be declared the winner. Teams with less than five (5) bowlers will take a zero (0) for the frames of their missing bowlers. The team with the highest number of pins (per division) will be declared the winner. Should a tie occur, the team with the highest single game score will be declared the winner. The winning team in each division will get 300 points. A sliding scale will be used to determine the score for all other teams
- Shoes and balls will be provided to all participants, but you may also bring your own equipment to use.
