\$30 per person includes tickets to the event, experiences, and lunch provided at Lucas Oil Stadium.



## **Drop Off Information:**

- Buses/Vans will be able to drop-off in the zone indicated below in yellow off Missouri Street between Gates 1 & 3.
- All field trip attendees will enter the Stadium through the South Gate. There will be entry gates on the West end (Missouri St.) specifically for groups where one individual will have multiple tickets on their phone.



### **Bus/Van Parking Information:**

- All buses or vans will be able to park at Gate 10 Events. This is a surface lot located on 917 South Kenwood Ave. located off of McCarty St. between Capitol Ave. and Illinois St.
- All vehicles should print the attached parking pass and place on their dashboard.

#### **Pick-up Information:**

 Buses and vans will be able to pick up field trip attendees outside of the Indiana Convention Center on Maryland Street and Capitol Ave following their experience.

#### Wristband

- Each attendee will receive a wristband to identify them as part of our field trip group.
- Please let us know if there are children in your group that cannot be photographed. We
  will be sure to distribute a different color wristband to ensure we do not photograph
  those individuals.
- Volunteers will be wearing a gold wristband, a volunteer uniform, and volunteer credential.

#### In Case of Inclement Weather

- Please monitor the weather in advance of your field trip date and instruct your group to
  dress appropriately as we will need to walk outside to get into the Stadium and to the
  Toyota Aqua Zone. If there is inclement weather, we will still host all indoor activities
  including Prelims at Lucas Oil Stadium and Toyota Aqua Zone experience. We will do
  our best to communicate with you as we have information and updates. Please feel free
  to reach out with any questions.
- Statement on bag policy, items can be left on their vehicle/bus. Clear drawstring bag being provided.

#### Lost/Stolen Items

#### **Lucas Oil Stadium Prohibited Items:**

For the protection of our fans, the following items are not permitted in Lucas Oil Stadium and cannot be stored by Lucas Oil Stadium personnel.

These items include, but are not limited to:

- Weapons or fireworks
- Missile-like objects
- Video cameras (at the discretion of each event promoter)
- Poles/sticks of any kind
- Large purses, bags and backpacks
- Liquor containers, bottles, cans, liquid containers and coolers (except for guests with special medical or dietary needs)
- Food not dispensed by Lucas Oil Stadium concessionaires
- Objects that obstruct another patron's view of the playing field
- Horns, bells, whistles, bullhorns, megaphones, klaxons, boom boxes and/or other noisemakers
- Animals (except assistive animals for guests with disabilities)

- Anything that creates a nuisance or disruptionSelfie Sticks

Patrons are subject to inspection of person, parcels, bags, containers and/or clothing capable of concealing prohibited items. Guests may refuse inspections, however, management reserves the right to refuse entry.
