THE NOTES TO KNOW

- Purdue steps back out of Big Ten play this weekend when it travels to Indianapolis for the Indy Classic to face Davidson. The unbeaten Boilermakers are one of seven remaining unbeaten teams nationally and are looking for their first 11-0 start in seven years.
- The game will pit Davidson star **Foster Loyer** (5th yr.) against his brother, **Fletcher Loyer** (Fr.). The two brothers are averaging a combined 32.6 points and 8.4 assists per game while shooting 53-of-139 (.381) from long range. The pair both won state honors as Foster was named Michigan's Mr. Basketball (2018) while Fletcher was named Indiana's Gatorade Player of the Year (2022).
- Purdue is looking to extend its non-conference, regular-season winning streak to 22 games, dating to a Dec. 8, 2020, loss at Miami, Fla. The win streak is the longest in the country by seven games (14 - UNLV).
- For the second straight year, Purdue has been voted No. 1 in the AP Top 25 poll. A year ago, Purdue was voted No. 1 on Dec. 6, for the first time in school history. Purdue becomes the first Big Ten team since Indiana (1974-75, 1975-76) to be ranked No. 1 in consecutive seasons.
- Purdue can claim America's best resume, owning a nation's-best four top-50 KenPom wins, all of them against teams ranked in the top 31. Three of the wins (Marquette was at home) have come away from Mackey Arena.
- Appearing at No. 1 in this week's AP Top 25, Purdue has been ranked in the top 5 in consecutive years for the first time since the 1986-87 and 1987-88 seasons. The Boilermakers have spent 15 of the past 25 AP polls ranked in the top 5. Only Gonzaga (22) has spent more time in the top 5 than Purdue since the start of last season.
- Purdue is 152-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 66-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season. Purdue has won 44 straight games when scoring at least 80 points.
- Purdue has made 164 free throws this season, while opponents have shot just 105. Purdue has made 90 more free throws (164 to 74) this season, the fourth-highest discrepancy in the country (Denver +100; New Mexico +95; North Carolina +91).
- Purdue is currently the fifth-youngest team among power-conference teams in America in terms of D-I experience (1.36) according to KenPom.com. The Purdue freshman class is averaging 28.9 points per game (37.1 percent of scoring). Over the last three games, the group has averaged 34.0 points per game, accounting for 42.7 percent of Purdue's scoring in that span (102 of 239 points).
- Through Thursday, **Zach Edey** ranks No. 1 in the KenPom PDV ratings by a significant margin and has been the game MVP in all 10 Purdue contests (unprecedented to start a season in the KenPom era) so far this year. It's the second-longest streak ever behind Ohio State's **Keita Bates-Diop** in 2017-18 (11 games). Including this season with Edey, Purdue has had a top-10 KenPom player in five of the last seven seasons. Edey ranks 7th in the country in scoring, 1st in rebounding, 19th in blocked shots and 33rd in field goal percentage.
- Perhaps our favorite **Zach Edey** stat: Through 10 games this year, he has more blocked shots (23) than personal fouls (19). He has also played 30 minutes eight times this season after not doing it once in his first two seasons, including 43 minutes vs. Nebraska last Saturday. He is averaging just 2.4 fouls per 40 minutes played this season.
- Edey became the first Big Ten player since **Ethan Happ** (Nov. 2018) to be named Big Ten Player of the Week in three consecutive weeks. His three Big Ten Player of the Week awards (in only five weeks) are tied for the third most in a season in Purdue history.
- Fletcher Loyer** has been named Big Ten Freshman of the Week twice this season (Nov. 28, Dec. 5). The two awards are the third most for a freshman in Purdue history (**Caleb Swanigan**, **Vince Edwards** - 3).
- Matt Painter** needs six overall victories to become the fifth coach in Big Ten history with 400 victories while at a conference school (**Bob Knight**, **Tom Izzo**, **Gene Keady**, **Lou Henson**). He needs four victories to become the seventh coach with 200 Big Ten Conference victories.

THE SERIES WITH THE WILDCATS

• Purdue leads the series with Davidson by a 2-0 margin, winning each game at a neutral site by at least 16 points. The two teams haven't met since Nov. 16, 2018, in the semifinals of the Charleston Classic.

• The first meeting came in Dec. 2008, in the Wooden Tradition in Indianapolis. Purdue fans still talk about it as **Chris Kramer** and **Lewis Jackson** held **Steph Curry** to 5-of-26 shooting and 13 points in a 76-58 victory. We aren't sure what became of **Steph Curry**, but believe he is in the NBA now having some success.

BOILERMAKERS MOVE TO THE TOP SPOT

• A year ago, Purdue ascended to the top spot in the AP Top 25 poll for the first time in school history on Dec. 6, only to lose the ranking a week later by losing on a buzzer-beater at Rutgers. This year's team hopes the stay is a little longer.

• Purdue is the first Big Ten program to be ranked No. 1 in consecutive seasons since Indiana in 1975 and 1976. It has only happened three times total in AP Top 25 poll history.

• Purdue started the season unranked in the AP Top 25 poll, but ascended to the top spot just 34 days after its season began.

• From the date of that team's season opener, the rise was the quickest for an unranked team to No. 1 in AP Top 25 poll history. Purdue is the seventh team to go from unranked to No. 1 in the same season.

REACHING THESE LEVELS MEANS A VICTORY

• Purdue has won 52 straight games when shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 70.0 percent from the free throw line, last losing to Illinois on March 3, 2004 (81-79; ot). The Boilermakers have reached those marks twice this year, defeating West Virginia and Minnesota.

2-0 STARTS ARE SIGNIFICANT IN BIG TEN PLAY

• With its win over Nebraska, Purdue is 2-0 in Big Ten play for the first time since the 2017-18 team started 2-0. Purdue has started 2-0 in Big Ten play six times under Painter.

• In the years under Painter that Purdue started 2-0 in Big Ten play, the Boilermakers are a combined 67-25 (.728).

• Purdue is 53-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game, winning 24 straight games.

• Purdue is 152-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 66-2 since the start of the 2017-18 season. Purdue has won 44 straight games when scoring 80 or more points (last loss vs. Notre Dame on Dec. 15, 2018).

• Purdue is 140-15 under Coach Painter when winning both the turnover and rebound battles.

• Purdue has won 19 straight games when 5 players score 10+ points.

• Purdue has won 111 straight games when scoring 90 or more points, dating to Nov. 24, 1987 – a span of 12,808 days.

► **Record at Purdue:** 394-192 (.672) / 18th year | **Career Record:** 419-197 (.680) / 19th year

- With six Sweet 16 appearances, 13 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 18th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to seven straight NCAA Tournaments – the sixth-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in four of the last five tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter will enter the 2022-23 season second on the school's all-time wins list (384) behind legendary mentor **Gene Keady** and ahead of **Ward "Piggy" Lambert**, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 17 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 23.5 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in 10 of his 18 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
- Painter has averaged 11.4 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 13 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 15 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 14 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2023 – Painter is 52 years old).
