Frequently Asked Questions

- WHERE DO I SUBMIT TEAM MEMBER NAMES?
 - Even though you will secure your time slots on our registration site, we still need the names of your teammates. All team member names must be submitted by August 20, 2020. You may:

- WHAT IF OUR TEAM IS SPLIT INTO DIFFERENT SESSIONS?
 - It's OK! As long as we know the names of your team, registration in different sessions is possible. For example, if only four slots are available for one time, but there are six members of your team, simply add four to your cart for one time slot and the other two to a different time slot. We will have your teams grouped in our telemetry on event day.
- WHAT ABOUT COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES?
 - The MINI Challenge is a low density, outdoor event with ample room for social distancing. With the event being held the day before the ISC Corporate Challenge, there will be no spectators. Participant volume is just 12 people per each 1/2 hour driving session during the event. This is well under Marion County's Stage 3 recommended capacity of 100 people for social gatherings. Stage 3 was activated for Marion County on June 1, 2020. 4 of the 12 people will be in cars at any given time, leaving only 8 remaining participants in an expansive outdoor setting. The cars' windows and sunroofs will be open during the event for maximum fresh air circulation. Hand sanitizer and disposable gloves will be available for all participants wishing to use them. Waste receptacles will be placed for the safe disposal of gloves. Masks will not be provided, but you are free to wear your own.
